Zinc Taste Test

Assessment of zinc tissue levels

Saliva pH Challenge Test

Measures alkaline buffer response

Urinary Chemstrip 10 Test

Dip & test for specific gravity, pH, leukocytes, nitrite, protein, alucose, ketones, urobilinogen, bilirubin & blood in urine

Urinary Vitamin C Test

Test for sufficiency of Vitamin C consumption

KOENISBURG - Urinary Adrenal Test

Useful in detecting Hypoadrenia or Hyperadrenia
